1. Definitions

In these rules:

Colour Chips are chips of a particular set, bearing the same emblem or mark to distinguish them from colour chips used at other tables.

Field Bet means a wager on the sum total of the uppermost side of the 3 dice equal to 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, 15 or 16.

Single Dice Bet means a wager placed on any one of the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

Spin means to turn the dice cage by using the handle attached to the cage, causing it to rotate and the dice to tumble.

2. Mode of Play

2.1 The Layout

2.1.1 Mini Dice may be played only on tables displaying the layout as shown in Appendix "A".

3. How to Play

- 3.1 Commencement of play shall begin when the Dealer announces "Place your bets, please."
- 3.2 Closing of bets shall take effect when the Dealer announces "No more bets."
- 3.3 Each Player shall play the game of Mini Dice by placing the cash chips and/or Colour Chips in accordance to Appendix "A".
- 3.4 The Dealer shall spin the dice cage three times to constitute a valid game.
- 3.5 The winning combination shall be determined by the numeric value of each dice when the dice cage comes to a complete stop with the weight on one side of the dice cage at the bottom and all the dice lie flat down.

4. Settlement

4.1 Odds of Each Winning Wager

Mini Dice Pay Table	
Single Dice Bet	Pays
1 number appearing on 1 dice	1 to 1
1 number appearing on 2 dice	2 to 1
1 number appearing on 3 dice	12 to 1
Field Bet	Pays
Total sum of 3 dice equal to 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, 15 or 16	1 to 1

5. Irregularities

- 5.1 In the event that any of the following situations occur, the game shall be considered void:
 - 5.1.1 The Dealer does not cause the dice cage to spin at least three (3) times;
 - 5.1.2 One dice rests on top of another;
 - 5.1.3 One or more dice are damaged; or
 - 5.1.4 Any of the three dice fail to come to rest with one surface flat to the base of the tumbler.
- 5.2 After the Dealer announces "No more bets", no wager may be placed, increased or withdrawn and the Dealer will refuse all such wagers.
